We cannot offer admission to the HEOP program until we receive both your 2025-26 FAFSA and your NYS TAP (Tuition Assistance Program) application. The TAP application should be submitted using school code 0130.

## WHAT IS THE HIGHER EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM?

The Arthur O. Eve Higher Education Opportunity Program (HEOP) is a partnership between the University of Mount Saint Vincent and the New York State Education Department (NYSED). This program is designed for students who have the potential and drive to further their education, but, due to limited academic and financial resources, would not otherwise have the opportunity to attend college. The goal of HEOP is to retain and graduate promising students who will succeed at the college level and beyond.

## **Economic Eligibility Criteria**

To be considered for the Arthur O. Eve Higher Education Opportunity Program, the applicant's family income must fall within the ranges provided in the following chart:

Exceptions to the economic guidelines can be made if the applicant falls into one of the following categories, and proper documentation can be submitted:

- The student is living with foster parents who do not provide support for college, and no money is provided by the birth parents.
- The student is a ward of the state or county.
- The student and/or student's family receives public assistance.
